

## **Movement of People Israel and Palestine**

**Like many other countries, the land that is now Israel and Palestine has been subject to great movements of people both into and out of the country. Following World War II many people were displaced and some of them moved to what was then Palestine. The creation of the State of Israel in 1948 led to further movement of hundreds of thousands of people both into and out of the new state.**

### **Activity**

Look at the map showing movement of people into and out of the State of Israel between 1948-1951.

In your group, look closely at the map. The width of arrows tells you the number of people who moved. A thick arrow means many people moved, a thin arrow shows a smaller number.

Now list 4 things the map tells you.

Write down any questions you have about the map.

Join with another group. Do you have the same list? Do you have different questions? Add any new information to your list.

**Width of arrows indicates the relative number of people who moved, not often by choice.**
