

Conflict and Cooperation Flashcards

July 2000

Camp David Summit - Israel and Palestinian leader met to come to a peaceful solution to the conflict.

Much of the land in the West Bank is not available to Palestinians.

Palestinians have to queue at checkpoints to be able to get to work or to access health services.

March 2007

Valley of Peace initiative - a venture between Israel and Palestine with the focus on joint business opportunities.

Israeli children talk about being afraid of rocket attacks and people coming through tunnels from Gaza.

Israeli and Palestinian children very rarely have any opportunity to meet and play together.

October 2002

IPSO - a science organisation with one of its aims being the co-operation of Israeli and Palestinian in science education.

February 2014

Roots Project - works with Israeli and Palestinian communities in order to create a path to peace.

Israeli neighbourhoods near Gaza have bomb shelters to protect civilians from possible rocket attacks.

September 1993

Oslo Accords - Israeli and Palestinian leaders agreed a peace process that would aim to end the violence as a result of several measures.

2005

Institute of Circle work - unites Israeli and Palestinian woman with a focus on leadership.

More than a year after the war in Gaza a shortage of construction materials mean that thousands of people are still without adequate shelter.
